You do not need a professional organization to represent your interest in these three areas, but it is a part of the many services offered to members of KEA in Klein. KEA leadership strongly recommends that you let KEA assist you because of legalities, timelines, and protocol that you may not be aware of. KEA has an extensive history of working positively with KISD administration to resolve member issues at the lowest possible level so as to promote the mission of both TSTA and KISD equitably.
